PURPOSE:

The purpose of this order is to establish policy pursuant to the Prostitution Investigation Act (PA103-1071).

POLICY:

The Fox Lake Police Department is committed to the suppression of organized crime and vice and will aggressively identify and investigate all reports and findings of organized crime and vice activity. It is the policy of the Fox Lake Police Department that every sworn officer clearly recognizes his/her responsibility to support law enforcement actions to suppress organized crime and various vice activities.

I. DEFINITIONS

- A. Prostitution Investigation Act – Illinois Public Act 103-1071 (5 ILCS 812/ et.al.)
- B. "Law enforcement agency" and "law enforcement officer" have the meanings ascribed to them in Section 10-10 of the Law Enforcement Officer-Worn Body Camera Act.
- C. "Prostitution" has the meaning ascribed to it in Section 11-14 of the Criminal Code of 2012.
- D. "Sexual penetration" has the meaning ascribed to it in Section 11-0.1 of the Criminal Code of 2012.

II. Responsibilities

- A. The Fox Lake Police Department prohibits law enforcement officers from knowingly and willingly performing an act of sexual penetration with the suspect of a criminal investigation of prostitution during the course of an investigation conducted by that officer.
- B. This policy shall be posted and made publicly available.
